

Request for Embargo (Delayed Release) of Thesis or Dissertation

The University at Buffalo requires that scholarly work conducted by graduate students and incorporated into theses and dissertations be made publicly available through <u>UB's Institutional Repository (UBIR)</u>. Graduate students own the copyright to their original works of authorship while granting UB a nonexclusive, worldwide, royalty-free, perpetual license for dissemination of their thesis or dissertation through the UBIR.

By filing this form, students may request an embargo to temporarily delay the public release of their thesis or dissertation for the reasons below. If the embargo request is approved, the delay period will expire 12 months or 24 months from the student's official degree conferral date. Should an embargo extension be needed, the extension request must be received by the Graduate School at least one month before the expiration of the initial embargo period.

Students applying for an embargo must still submit their work electronically through the ETD Administrator portal by the conferral materials deadline.
